WHAT IS NI'N AQ NO'KMAQ?

Ni'n aq No'kmaq translates to "Me and My Relations."

It is the process by which WE, the Epekwitnewaq Mi'kmaq (and not the Federal and Provincial governments) determine who can exercise **Aboriginal and Treaty Rights** in PEI.

It is the Epekwitnewaq Mi'kmaq's first step towards re-establishing self-determination.



GOALS OF NI'N AQ NO'KMAQ

To have a **streamlined process** of determining who can exercise Aboriginal and Treaty Rights on PEI.

To **protect against** individuals who are pretending to be Mi'kmaq when they are not.

To ensure that the Aboriginal and Treaty Rights of future Epekwitnewaq Mi'kmaq generations – our children and grandchildren – **are protected**.
