## WHAT IS NI'N AQ NO'KMAQ?

Ni'n aq No'kmaq translates to  
“**Me and My Relations.**”

It is the process by which WE, the Epekwitnewaq Mi'kmaq (and not the Federal and Provincial governments) determine who can exercise **Aboriginal and Treaty Rights** in PEI.

It is the Epekwitnewaq Mi'kmaq's first step towards re-establishing **self-determination.**



## GOALS OF NI'N AQ NO'KMAQ

To have a **streamlined process** of determining who can exercise Aboriginal and Treaty Rights on PEI.

To **protect against** individuals who are pretending to be Mi'kmaq when they are not.

To ensure that the Aboriginal and Treaty Rights of future Epekwitnewaq Mi'kmaq generations – our children and grandchildren – **are protected**.

Who do we consider to be **Mi'kmaq**?

When our Treaties say “our heirs, and the heirs of our heirs forever” – **who does that mean** to us?

Who should have access to Mi'kmaq **Treaty Rights**?
