

Since 2020, in recognition of Indigenous Awareness Week, L'nuey and the Government of Prince Edward Island have partnered to raise awareness of long-existing Mi'kmaw place names by raising heritage road signs across the province, while celebrating Epekwitk's Mi'kmaw history.

This is an important partnership with the Province in the spirit of Mi'kmaw language revitalization and reconciliation. These place names are very descriptive and rooted in natural and human history, in geography, and they provide a window into how we traditionally went about our daily lives.

- MEKWAPNKWEJK // WEST POINT (meg-wahbn-gwej)
 The place where, in the dawn, the face (bank) is red
- ELMINIKEJ // MIMINEGASH
 (el-mini-gehj)
 Let us carry something animate
 on our shoulders (portage)
- MTA'QANEJK // TIGNISH RIVER (mm-dah-ga-nehjg)
 Paddle place
- ATOQWA'SUE'KAQN // MILL RIVER
 (ah-doh-hwah-suey-gah-hahn)
 Trouting place
- KESKAMKEK // CASCUMPEC BAY
 (ges-gam-gek)
 The place where the sand vanishes
 from sight
- MESKI'K PU'TA'SK // PORTAGE LAKE (mess-geeg boo-dahsk)
- A large cavity

 UNIKANSUK // PORTAGE
- (oon-ee-gan-soogk)
 Portage trail
- MNTUAPSKUK // CAP-EGMONT (mn-dooahp skoog)
 Devil's rock
- AMASISIPUKWEK // GRAND RIVER
 (ah-ma-sis-ee-boog-weg)
 The river where it stretches out and follows far into the distance
- MUINAQANEJK // PORT HILL (moo-een-ahqa-nejk)
 Bear thing place

- KIKJI-SIPUKWEK // LENNOX CHANNEL (gig-jee-see-boo-gweg)
 The place where the river stretches out and follows close and near to shore
- KWESAMALIKEK // BEECH POINT
 (gwesa-mah-lee-gegk)
 It is the variegated shape thing that
 protects or shelters
- KATAQANEK // KENSINGTON
 (gah-dah-haw-nehg)
 At the place of the thing related to
 or made from or connected to eels
- EPTEK // BEDEQUE
 (ehb-dehg)
 It is hot
- PASTUE'KATI // BORDEN
 (bahs-doo-way-ga-dee)
 A place where seacows are plentiful

 (gej-ee-boog-weg)
 The place where one is knowledgeable

 (dah-boo doo-eh-dihn)
 Double narrows

 Canoe cove
- SUOMANE'KATIK // RICE POINT
 (sue-ah-mahn-eh-gah-deeg)
 The place where beech nuts are plentiful
- JI'KA'WE'KATIK // WEST RIVER
 (jee-gah-way-gah-deegk)
 The place where bass are plentiful
- KUNTAL KWESAWE'KL // ROCKY POINT (guhn-dahl gwes-ah-way-gel)
 - (guhn-dahl gwes-ah-way-gel) Rocky point
- NEMTAQAQ // NORTH RIVER
 (nem-da-hahq)
 Being able to see strait up or along until
 disappearing from view

- TLAQATIK // TRACADIE
 (dla-ha-deegk)
 The place where people gather; the gathering place
- PUKU'SAMKEK SIPU // MORELL RIVER
 (boo-goo-sahm-geg see-boo)
 At the place, in the river, where there are
 plenty of clams in the sand
- MEKWA'SIK SIPU // VERNON RIVER
 (meg-wah-sig see-boo)
 The river is full of redness
- MEWISITEK // ORWELL (meh-wee-see-dehg)
 The berry picking place
- 29 MEKWASEY // BELFAST (meg-wah-say)
- (meg-wah-say)
 The thing of redness
- WEJUOWITK // POINT PRIM
 (weh-jew-oh-wheetk)
 Flowing close by
- MUINEWEY SIPU // BELLE RIVER
 (moo-een-eh-wey see-boo)
 The river of the bear, where the bears are found or the bears go
- MUINEK // MURRAY RIVER
 (moo-een-egk)
 At the bear place
- wokwisewey sipu // Fox River (woah-gwis-eh-way see-boo)
 Fox river
- ESKWATEK // MURRAY HARBOUR
 (ess-gwah-dehg)
 She or he is in a place where she or he is
- KWESOQAMKIAQ // PANMURE ISLAND (gwes-oh-hahm-gee-ahk)
 Sand bar
